## GARY DENOUNCED UNBER PItOTEST,

Trade und Labor Assembly Pakses Some Kavanugh Fesolntions.
Sontrary to the wish of President Linehan of tho Trade and Labor Assembly that body yesterday adopted resolutions violently dencuncing Judge Gary. Mr. Linchat protested against the introduction of the resolutioms on the ground that it was an attempt by interested politicians to capture the assembly. He said he himself would vote against Judge Gary, but as President of the assembly it was his duty to uphold the constitution. He thercupon tendered his resignation at the close of the meeting, and it was accepted, altlough with much regret.

Tho resolutions were sprung unnexpectedly on the meeting. They were introduced by Mrs. Kute Kavanagh, one of the factory insyectors appointed by Gov. Aligeld. When President Linchan declared them out of ordis an eppenl from the decision was tuten, but the meeting upheld his ruling. Then the resolutions were referred to the Committee on Resolutions, who knocked out the preamble aud eubstituted for it a letter by Henry D. Lloyd, which, under the title of "An Exposure of Judge Gary," has been circulated largely during the campuign. The resolutions, as amended, wore carried. Great excitement and disorder prevailed during the whole discussion. "Tommy" Morgaz mado a charactoristically violent speeeh in support of the resolutions, and when they were carried offered to bear the whule cost of publication. This was because a considerable section of the delegates present objected to have the funds of the assembly depleted by the expense of printing the 60,000 copies ordered fo be circulnted by the moeting. Whether Gov. Altgeld will permit Mr. Morgan to burclen himself with all this expense must necessarily' remain a state secret. It is thought by many it is an occasion for doing good by stealth, with adequate precautions against having to blush to find it fame.
