Frank Carter one of the Judges of said Court, by the petition of *Lucius T. Abbott*, together with the day and cause of caption and detention; then and there to perform and abide such order and directions as our said Circuit Court of Cook County shall make in that behalf.

HEREOF make due return forthwith under the penalty of what the law directs.
